**For Immediate Release**

Will County Clerk, Nancy Schultz Voots, wishes to inform voters that the General Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, February 5, 2008. Voters will need to be prepared to declare party affiliation in this Primary Election (Republican, Democratic, Green parties) or Nonpartisan (referendum only – no candidates, if applicable). Available options to voters are:

**Early Voting** (Public Act 94-645) – No reason required – With legislation moving the election up a month and unpredictable weather conditions, consider Early Voting.

Vote at County Clerk's Office or one of 28 early voting sites throughout the County beginning January 14<sup>th</sup> through January 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Absentee Voting** – Must give reason voter will be unable to vote at polling place on Election Day, such as expect to be out of county, student away at school, serving as Election Judge, physically incapacitated. Absentee voting is offered in-person, by mail or via Will County Clerk's website.

**Voting at your polls** – Election Day voting at your designated polling place. Polls are open 6:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. Refer to your Voter Registration card for polling place.

The County Clerk's office is located at 302 N. Chicago Street, Joliet. Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to noon. The County Clerk's office will be closed on Monday, January 1<sup>st</sup>, Saturday, January 19<sup>th</sup> and Monday, January 21<sup>st</sup>.
