WILL COUNTY ELDERLY & HANDICAPPED VOTERS

Please be advised that the following voting aids are available to assist the elderly and handicapped voters in Will County in the General Primary Election held on February 5, 2008.

VOTING BOOTH Every polling place will have a voting booth designed to accommodate those persons using a wheelchair.

HAND HELD
MAGNIFIER To enlarge the ballot.

CURBSIDE
VOTING Available for voters who are physically unable to enter the polling place. Call the Will County Clerk's Office at 815/740-4616 for information.

VOTING
ASSISTANCE Handicapped and Elderly voters requiring help may be assisted by a friend, relative or by the Election Judges at the polling place.

ABSENTEE
VOTING Available for persons unable to vote in person on election day. Call the Will County Clerk's Office at 815/740-4632 for nearest location.

VOTER
REGISTRATION Available at municipal and township offices, as well as other locations throughout the county. Call the Voter Registration Department at 815/740-4620 for the Registrar nearest you or if special arrangements need to be made.

NEW ADA
AutoMARK Ballot-marking technology that allows voters with disabilities and other special needs to mark a ballot privately and independently when using an optical scan voting system.

The last day to register to vote for the February 5, 2008 General Primary Election is Tuesday, January 8, 2008.
